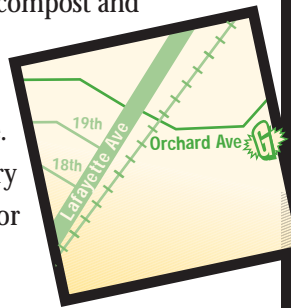

SIX STEPS to Greenlands ultra-premium compost

1 Yard debris is collected and ground into small pieces.

2 Microorganisms break down the debris via aerobic decomposition.

3 Compost exceeds 150 degrees Fahrenheit, hot enough to kill weed seeds.

4 Greenlands staff monitor temperature, moisture and oxygen levels to ensure optimum decomposition conditions.

5 Compost is thoroughly aerated to balance temperature and oxygen levels.

6 Six months to a year later, when the material is fully cured, compost is screened and ready for use.

Fine Garden Compost

A dark, nutrient-rich mulch made from 100% plant matter. Use compost to promote moisture retention, erosion control, drainage, disease suppression and decreased soil compaction; also use as a barkdust alternative.

Sandy Loam (topsoil)

A sandy base soil. Ideal for breaking up clay soils and filling in holes.

Compsoil

A carefully balanced soil amendment containing 50% fine garden compost and 50% sandy loam. Mix with existing soil to add volume and nutritional properties to lawns and gardens.

Quarter Mix

A special soil amendment mix with 25% fine garden compost and 75% sandy loam. Mix with existing soil to add volume while maintaining overall organic matter levels.

Potting Soil

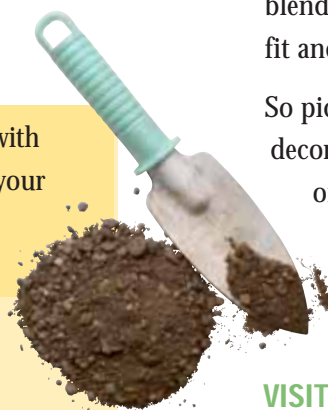
A mix of 50% *Nutriboost™* compost, 25% pumice and 25% peat moss. The ideal nutrient mixture for potted plants.

	Medium Fir <i>Deep red, freshly ground fir bark screened to 3/4".</i> A great topdressing for planting beds; also use as a filler component in potting mix.
	Premium Fir <i>Aged ground fir bark with a deep red color and screened to 1/2".</i> A premium topdressing for planting beds; also use as a filler component in potting mix.
	Hemlock <i>Aged ground hemlock bark screened to 3/4"; chocolate brown color.</i> A sliverless topdressing for planting beds; ideal for people with children or pets.
	Alder Sawdust <i>Ground and shipped directly from a local alder mill.</i> Excellent for frost prevention, mud control and bird deterrent or as a thin topdressing to retain moisture in recently seeded lawns.
	Cedar Chips <i>Cedar woodchips sized to 2" to 4".</i> A long-lasting barkdust alternative, cedar chips make excellent bedding for pathways, play areas and kennels.
	Peat Moss <i>Grown on a freshwater bog.</i> Use as a soil structure enhancer or absorbent dressing.
	Sand <i>Carefully washed concrete sand.</i> Smooths out and fills flagstone pathways, patios and sandboxes; mix with soil to promote drainage.
	Pea Gravel <i>Rounded rocks approximately 3/8" in diameter.</i> Helps prevent flooding by promoting drainage; also use for pathways or play areas.
	Crushed 1/4" Rock <i>Crushed gravel screened to 1/4".</i> Bedrock for pathways, patios and other areas needing compacted rock.
	Crushed 3/4" Rock <i>Crushed gravel screened to 3/4".</i> Medium grade compacted rock ideal for driveways or landscapes.
	Round 1 1/2" Rock <i>Round river rock sorted and screened to 1 1/2" to 1 3/4".</i> Use as a drain rock, for decoration or to maintain a clean kennel.
	Red Lava Rock <i>Red pumice stones sized to 1/2" to 3/4".</i> An attractive decorative rock; keeps pond filtration systems running smoothly.
	Decorative Rock <i>Flagstone rocks, boulders, and basalt columns in various shapes, sizes and colors.</i> Decorative rock that beautifies landscapes or gardens.
