

Important Information

Out by 6am

Set out your garbage and recycling by 6am on your scheduled pick-up day (or set them out the night before). Your actual service time may vary from week to week.

Holidays

Service occurs as usual on every holiday except for Thanksgiving and Christmas. For these two holidays, service will occur one day late for the rest of the week. If Christmas falls on a weekend, there is no change in the pick-up schedule. Our main office, the recycling center and Greenlands are closed on all major holidays.

Office Hours

Our main office is located on 1850 Lafayette Avenue in McMinnville. We are open 8am to 5pm, Monday through Friday. We also have a secure after-hours payment drop box.

Recovery Zone

The WOW Recovery Zone accepts trash, appliances, wood, electronics, car batteries, tires and more. Fees apply for most items. 2200 NE Orchard Avenue in McMinnville.

Why are we changing?

Commingled (mixed) recycling is a more efficient, user-friendly collection method. The cart is easy to use - just follow the instructions on the red lid. With your help, we can recycle more than ever before!



Using automated trucks to pick up your recycling will help us be more efficient and serve you better.

Every Other Week

Curbside recycling will be picked-up Every Other Week on your service day. Service day may be different than trash day for less than weekly garbage customers.

Preparation

Please rinse and flatten containers. OK to mix materials loose in the cart. No need to bag or separate items. Please do **not** use plastic bags.

Motor Oil

Place **next to** your recycling cart in see through plastic jugs with tight-fitting lid.

No Trash

No Styrofoam, packing peanuts, plastic bags, food waste, paper plates or cups, tissue or paper towels.

Paper, Metals & Plastic Bottles Together in one cart!

What's In:

Cardboard, Newspaper, Magazines,
Phone Books, Tin Cans, Aluminum,
Plastic Bottles & Scrap Metal*

*(must be less than 30 lbs. & 30 inches)

What's New:

Cereal Boxes, Junk Mail, Milk Cartons,
Drink Boxes, Envelopes, Printer Paper
and Shredded Paper (use paper bags)



What's Out:

Glass bottles and jars will **not** be accepted at the curb. Glass will make other items in your cart unrecyclable. Please bring your glass to one of our recycling depots (bottles and jars only - no dishes, Pyrex, or window glass)

Remember the 5 F's:

Free of Contaminants - No other plastics (Styrofoam, packing peanuts, bags, tubs, cups, or toys). No food waste, paper plates, tissues, paper towels, or food-contaminated paper.

Free-falling - Make sure that items will fall out when your cart is dumped.

Fit - All items must fit inside your cart. Take extra items to a recycling depot. Do not leave items outside of cart.

Flatten - Flatten large items.

Full - Set out your cart when full. If your cart is nearly empty, please wait until your next pick-up day. We want to make every stop count!
